Opportunity Development Centers, Inc. (ODC) is a private not-for-profit (501c3) that has been serving the Central Wisconsin area since 1965. Our mission is to "empower people with disabilities to achieve their work and life goals."

Every person is valuable and has unique abilities and ideas to contribute to the workplace and the community. ODC supports over 1,200 individuals on an annual basis and operates in 22 of Wisconsin's 72 counties. We offer a variety of programs and services, which include employment (job development and supported employment) community pre-vocational training, group supported employment, self-employment, school transition, Project SEARCH, mental health services (including outpatient mental health clinics), children's long-term support, community day services, independent living skills, housing counseling, virtual services and community connection services.

All of ODC's programs are designed and intended to promote independent living, inclusion and community integration of people with disabilities within the workplace and all aspects of community life. In Merrill, our focus is on offering community day services that facilitate volunteer opportunities with organizations such as Meals on Wheels, Children's Wisconsin, Pine Crest Nursing Home, and St. Stephens Church. Additionally, our Merrill location provides employment services, independent living skills training, and resources for building community connections.

Corporation (WEDC) has opened a grant
program for local organizations to start
innovative programs to support small
businesses.

Local and regional economic development organizations, municipalities, tribal governments, and counties are all eligible to submit proposals. Up to 40 communities will be awarded grants ranging from \$50,000 to \$250,000.

This Small Business Development Grant (SBDG) program is designed to build on the success of the popular "Mainstreet Bounceback" program from 2021-2022. The deadline for applications is **October 18**, with winners announced in early 2025.


